MEDICATION

PRESCRIPTION and NON-PRESCRIPTION

REFERENCE: Parent-Student Handbook, 2009-2010.

Medication required by a student shall not be administered at school, during regular school hours or during school-related activities, unless absolutely necessary to maintain the continued attendance of the student. This policy shall apply to both prescription and non-prescription medication. If it is determined that a student shall receive medication at school, the following procedures shall be followed:

1. Physicians written order required (form is available from health aide).
2. Parent request from superintendent required (form is available from health aide).
3. Medication shall be brought to school in the prescription bottle clearly stating the students' name, dosage, and expiration date.
4. Medication shall be retained by the school's Administration in a locked space.

Further regulations regarding administration of prescription and non-prescription medication is available in the Parent-Student Handbook, 2009-2010 or please consult your child's principal or health aide.
