

Next Steps for Development of:

Long-Range Planning Recommendations for the Board

Identify Priorities

- Develop consensus on District priorities to guide planning.
- Architects facilitate a Committee process, involving some or all of the following stakeholders:
 - Board
 - Administration
 - Staff
 - Community

Develop and Validate Design Options

- Architects develop design concepts and budgets to respond to identified priorities.
- Architects and Committee review options and validate feasibility based on:
 - Response to Priorities
 - Finance
 - Logistics

Explore Financial Options

Administration and financial consultants explore financial options.

<u>Report:</u> Architects compile report for the Board incorporating Priorities, Design and Financial Options, (with input from Administration and Financial consultants on finance).

<u>Timeline</u>: 3 – 6 months, depending on extent of community and staff participation desired.

<u>Fees:</u> Wold | Ruck Pate fees for facilitating the discussion of priorities, developing the design options, and compiling a report over the next 3 - 6 months would be \$24,000. Wold | Ruck Pate will credit half of this fee, or \$12,000, against our fee for a subsequent project of \$5,000,000 or more construction cost developed from the planning process.

<u>Follow-up Activities:</u> Board decision on a potential referendum, development of a local Referendum Campaign Committee, if needed, additional public information and outreach.
